Relevant Information	One scholarship is offered each year for graduate study at a Canadian University. There are no restrictions on the university or course of study, though applicants must independently gain admission to their programme. Foundation scholars are selected on criteria of character and extra-curricular interests, as well as academic excellence. All applicants must be permanent residents of the United Kingdom who have graduated from Oxford within 24 months of the application process.
About the donor	The Canadian Rhodes Scholars Foundation Scholarship is funded by Oxford alumni who were Rhodes Scholars from Canada, other Rhodes Scholars living in Canada and former beneficiaries of the CRSF scholarships.
