

## LEAVING A GIFT BY CODICIL

### SECURING THE FUTURE OF THE RHODES SCHOLARSHIPS

If you have already made a will, you can add a beneficiary to it by means of a codicil. The example wording below can be used by you or your solicitor to amend your existing will to make a bequest to support the Rhodes Scholarships.
