Selectors will use your CV to help assess how well you meet the selection criteria. Please write about your most relevant experiences in the template below. Once completed, save and upload the CV onto your Embark application.

**Please note you will be limited in the amount you can write in each section. If you run out of space, then please choose the experiences you feel are most important/ have made the greatest impact.**

**1. Professional/Research/Internship experience–** Below you can enter the details of your professional or research experiences. This may include employment positions, internships, research projects or entrepreneurialships.

**2. Volunteering, Community Involvement and Leadership experience-** Below, you can enter the details of any volunteering activities, community involvement, or leadership experience that you have. This may include mentoring, charity work, involvement in student organisations, advocacy, community involvement or any other informal, unpaid work you have done which demonstrates leadership or is for the benefit of others. Please note that any paid work should be entered above, under professional/research experience.

**3. Publications and presentations** -Please list any publications and/or presentations here. This may include academic articles or books, conference presentations, or other publications you have been involved in. You should include the key details such as author names, title and dates but please do not include abstracts. If you have an ORCID you may also include this.

**4. Awards, prizes and scholarships**- Please list any awards, prizes or scholarships you have received, including the name and date of the award and the organisation or institution that presented it.

**5. Skills, hobbies and extra-curricular activities**- Below please add the details of any skills, hobbies or extra-curricular activities you are involved in. For example, sports, music, languages, coding, creative and artistic endeavours, etc. You should include how long you have been involved in the activity, and if appropriate, the level of accomplishment or mastery, and any achievements (for example, taking part at a regional or national level, representing your educational institution, or achieving a certain grade or rank in a particular skill or activity).

**6. Other**- If there is an achievement that does not fit into one of the previous categories, please add it here (i.e. links to online art portfolios).
